causes physical or emotional harm to the other student or damage to the other student's property;

⁽ii) places the other student in reasonable fear of harm to himself or of damage to his property;

⁽iii) creates a hostile environment at school for the other student;

⁽iv) infringes on the rights of the other students at school; or

⁽v) materially and substantially disrupts the education process or the orderly operation of a school."

In accordance with M.G.L. c. 71, § 370, Cyberbullying means: "Bullying through the use of technology or any electronic communication, which shall include, but shall not be limited to, any transfer of signs, signals, writing, images, sounds, data or intelligence of any nature transmitted in whole or in part by a wire, radio, electromagnetic, photoelectronic or photo optical system, including but not limited to, electronic mail, internet communications, instant messages or facsimile communication. Cyber-bullying shall also include (i) knowing impersonation of another person as the author of posted content or messages, if the creator or impersonation creates any of the conditions enumerated in clauses (i) to (v), inclusive, of the definition of bullying. Cyber-bullying shall also include the distribution by electronic means of a communication to more than one person or the posting of material on an electronic medium that may be accessed by one or persons."
